

## MONDAY EVENING LEAGUE

## RULES FOR 2019

Starts on 20<sup>th</sup> May and continues through until 9<sup>th</sup> September, excluding 2 Bank Holidays and 1 Invitation evening.

All 6 teams will comprise of 5 players, from which 3 players will play each week.

All matches scheduled to start at 6.15 pm.

Team formation will be decided by the teams on the night.

Match result cards need to be formulated by the teams before play commences.

It would be advantageous to have 1 player responsible for each team.

Each players club handicap will be used to establish the team handicap for the match. So if team A has a joint handicap of 10 and they are against team B who have a joint handicap of 12 then team A will start with a score of plus 2 shots.

Players who cannot fulfil their allocated game must find a replacement from within their squad.

There are no trial ends, but on the first end of the game, only the winning shot will score.

Matches will be played over 16 ends and skips are not allowed to visit the head.

In the event that a match cannot be completed, 8 ends must be played for a result to be registered. If less than 8 ends are played the match is a draw.

3 points for a win and 1 point for a draw.

In the event of a tie on points at the end of the season, a play off will be arranged for Monday 16<sup>th</sup> September with a 5.15 pm start, to be played over 14 ends. Selection of teams will be the squads choice.

In the event of a "wash out" 1 point will be allocated to each team.

Teams that arrive with only 2 players will have their final score reduced by 25% (rounded down).

The team with 3 players will each have 3 woods and the team with 2 players will each have 4 woods.

During play the previous end winner will hold jack but the team with 3 players will always start and finish the end of play. Teams bowl alternatively with individual bowlers completing their set. Skips will change ends after 4 woods or 6 woods.

Any new player who has joined the club after the league teams are formulated will be offered as a replacement if a team player leaves or drops out.

If any disputes arises, the committee of Eric Moore, Rita Moore and Roger Lintott will adjudicate.
